Malaysia. Prior to the Covid-19 pandemic, the youth unemployment rate was 11.77%. As of the third quarter of 2021, that rate has increased over two percentage points to 13.9%. This is exacerbated by the fact that youth unemployment is almost three times the national average. Due to a lack of jobs, many Malaysian youths tend to work in jobs beneath their qualification; in other words, they are underemployed. The current rate of underemployment is at a staggering 31.2%. The lack of coordination between industry demands and expectations with the degree and/or qualification students are pursuing is another contributing factor to the growth in youth unemployment and underemployment. A hypothetical example is many students are pursuing law degrees, but there is a lack of demand for lawyers in the industry. Underemployment coupled with youth unemployment is causing many Malaysian youths to opt to work in foreign countries instead. Ultimately, this contributes to the ever-growing brain drain problem.



# UKEChange Healthcare: What is the Crisis Today?

The prevalence of childhood stunting in Malaysia has increased throughout the years, with the highest prevalence observed in low socio-economic status population groups at 639 800 households in 2020. In 2014, Khazanah Research Institute found that average households in Malaysia spend 17.7% of their monthly expenditure on food while a nutritious diet would require at least 25.7%. The lack of a nutritious diet introduces malnutrition which inadvertently leads to stunting. Urban poverty is the main driver for childhood stunting in Malaysia. Given the recent price hike in food, families resort to cheaper alternatives to satiate their hunger. These alternatives may include a meal consisting of rice and salted fish or soy sauce. Eating habits are also formed from the young and may perpetuate into adulthood. The unfortunate issue is that stunting is largely irreversible and stunted children will experience lifelong disadvantages.

In the face of an unrelenting financial and socio-political obstacle, how can soci protection and health systems work together to address childhood stunting urban areas in Malaysia?



**MODIFICATION.** This Affiliation MOU, as hereby amended and modified, may not be further amended or modified unless done so by a written agreement signed by the Parties.




