Buying your FIRST CAR

Rule of Thumb

- 1) Use 15% of salary for car monthly installment
E.g $15\% \times \text{RM}3,000 = \text{RM}450$
- 2) 20/5/15 - 20% down payment on a car
- 5 year car loan tenure
- Spend not more than 15% of monthly income on transportation expenses (loan payment, maintenance, gas, and car insurance)

AMENDMENT TO UKEC-KPUM
AFFILIATION MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between

This AMENDMENT TO the Affiliation MOU (hereinafter the "**Amendment**") between the United Kingdom and Eire Council for Malaysian Students (hereinafter "**UKEC**") and Kesatuan Penuntut Undang-Undang Malaysia di United Kingdom dan Eire (hereinafter "**KPUM**") is effective as of 24 August 2022, by and between the Parties (hereinafter each a "**Party**" to this Amendment and collectively the "**Parties**")

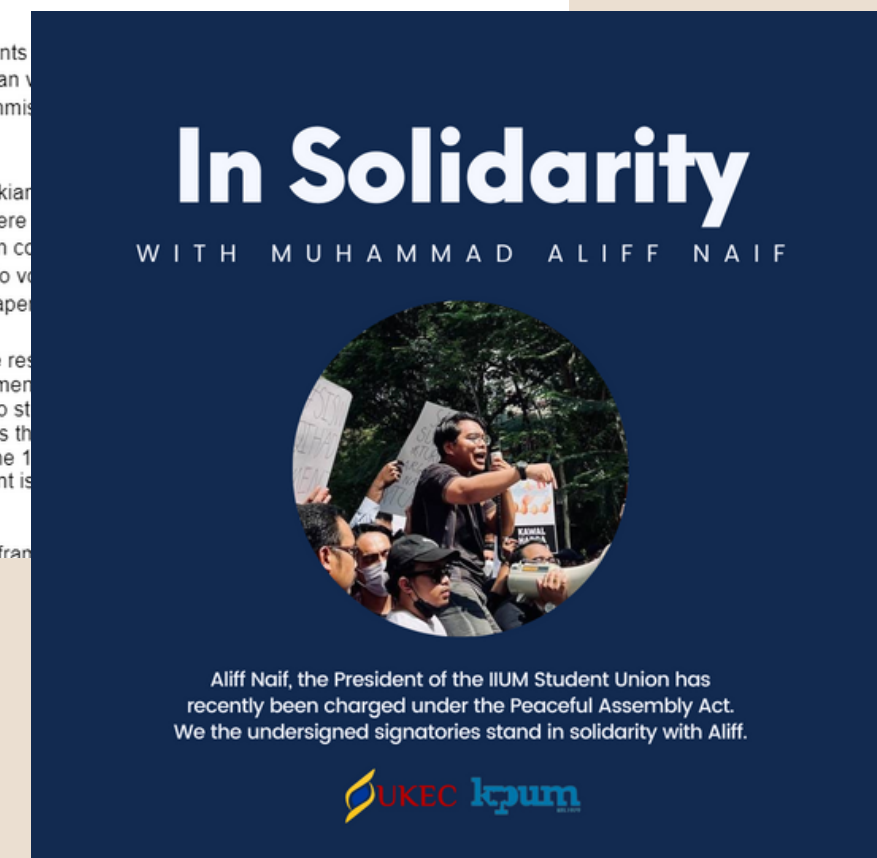
MODIFICATION. This Affiliation MOU, as hereby amended and modified, may not be further amended or modified unless done so by a written agreement signed by the Parties.

UKEC x KPUM MoU ammended to include clause on protecting free speech

- Recognised the need for solidarity among students to protect our rights to free speech.
- Wanted a long term accountability.
- Few things done to advance this MoU:
 - Hosted a roundtable session among UKE and Malaysian orgs
 - MoU drafted and signed with KPUM
 - MoU is tabled in KPUM's report and AGM
 - Joint statement to stand in solidarity with Aliff Naif



- Improved SC participation in media statements.
- More politically active whilst remaining non-partisan
- Statements released:
 - Joint Media Statement by International Student Bodies on the Issue of Late Ballot Papers
 - Advocacy on the increase in allowance of JPA-MARA Scholars
 - Joint Statement with KPUM: In Solidarity with Muhammad Aliff Naif
 - Formation of VoteMalaysia Coalition and Press Conference.

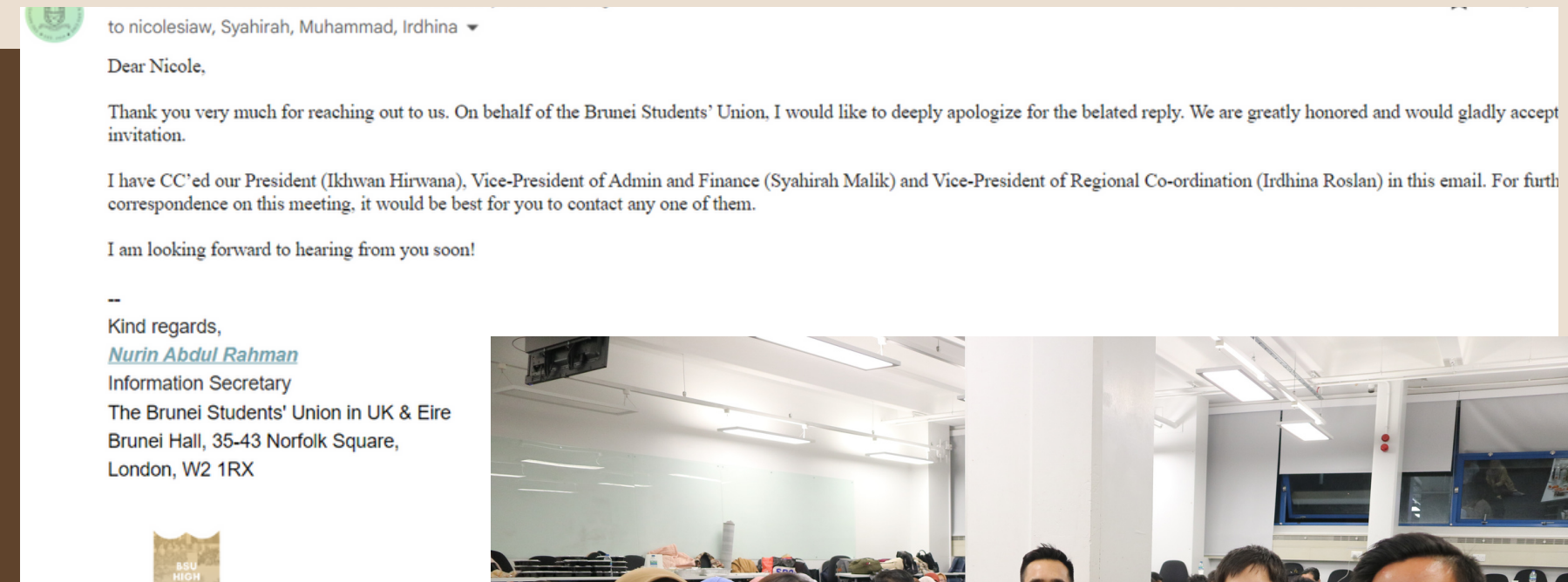

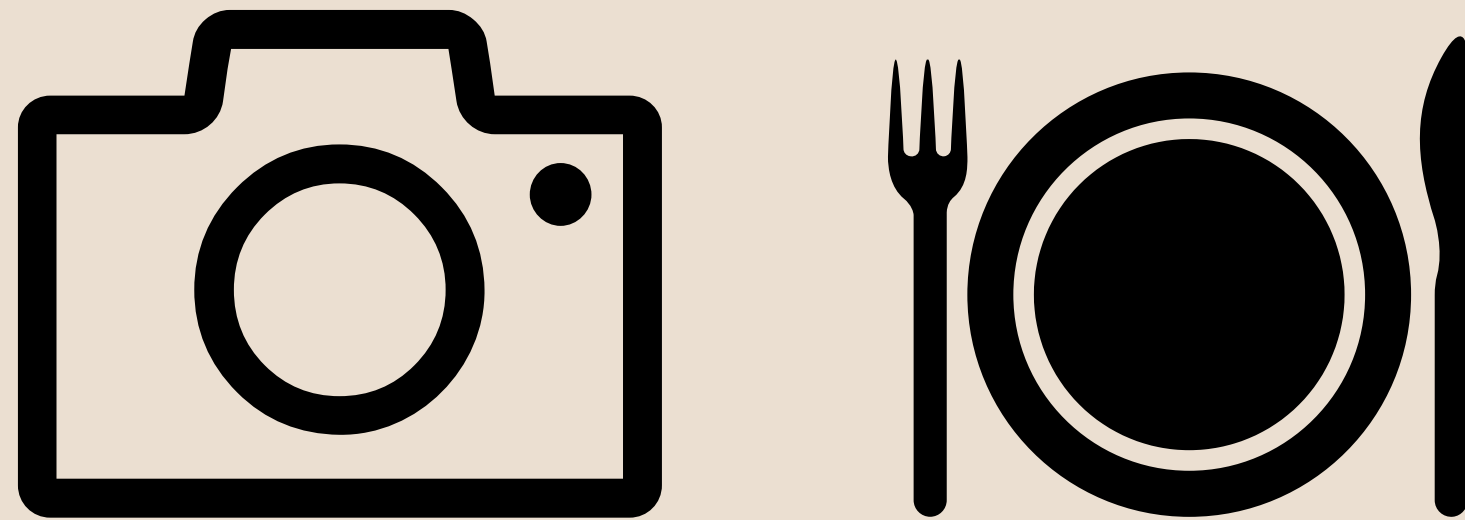

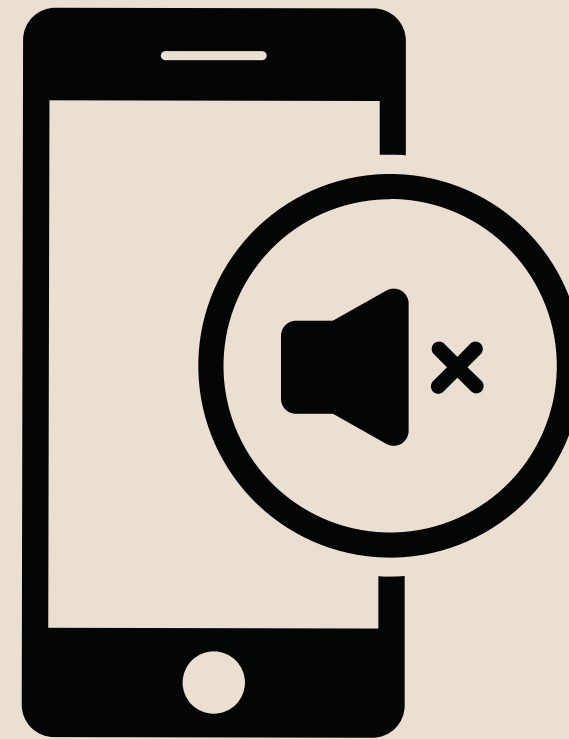
